

## Summer Study Starts Diverse Undergrads on the Path of PCO Success

The Pennsylvania College of Optometry (PCO) at Salus University recently welcomed a cohort of 14 PCO/Salus [Doctor of Optometry](#) applicants to its recently relaunched [Summer Enrichment Program \(SEP\)](#), renamed the Robert E. Horne SEP as a tribute to its founder, for high-achieving students of color. This year, the program's recruitment efforts placed a special emphasis on Black and African American students who are historically underrepresented in health science.



A closing ceremony, which featured special guest Robert E. Horne, wrapped up the events in mid-July. Horne, former vice president and dean of Student Affairs who retired from Salus in 2012, originally established the program in 1977.


