Sponsored by the Rehabilitation Services Administration, the Department of Blindness and Low Vision Studies (BLVS) at Drexel University, Elkins Park Campus (formerly Salus University) is offering partial tuition scholarships to students pursuing degrees or certificates in the following programs:

- Low Vision Rehabilitation (LVR)
- Vision Rehabilitation (VRT)



Called **Project PEP** (pre-employment partnerships), this grant will prepare future Low Vision Therapists and Vision Rehabilitation Therapists to work in the field of blindness and low vision. It emphasizes pre-employment skills for clients ages 14 and up.

Eligibility

- US citizens
- 3.0 GPA
- Completion of required documentation
- LVR and VRT students

Grant Funding

- Provides about 50% tuition scholarship for LVR or VRT courses
- Students who accept at least one full year of funding are eligible to “pay back” the grant via work
