



Federal/State License/Certification Disclosures

Each of the following Salus University programs qualifies a student to apply to take, or to take, the examination required to receive a Federal or State license or certification required as a precondition for the specified employment in the specified jurisdictions.

Program: Doctor of Audiology

Employment: Audiologist

Jurisdictions: Meets the requirements of all 50 States

Program: Doctor of Optometry – Traditional Program

Employment: Optometrist

Jurisdictions: Meets the requirements of all 50 States

Program: Doctor of Optometry – Scholars Program

Employment: Optometrist

Jurisdictions: Meets the requirements of 49 States, excepting [Oregon] for which the program has not made a determination regarding whether the program meets its requirements

Program: Master of Medical Science

Employment: Physician Assistant

Jurisdictions: Meets the requirements of all 50 States

Masters of Science and Certificate Program in Low Vision Rehabilitation

Employment: Certification by the Academy for Certification of Vision Rehabilitation and Education Professionals

Jurisdictions: Meets the national standard

Master of Science and Certificate Program in Orientation and Mobility

Employment: Certification by the Academy for Certification of Vision Rehabilitation and Education Professionals

Jurisdictions: Meets the national standard and those states where applicable

Master of Education and Certificate Program for Educators of Children and Youth with Visual Impairments

Employment: State Certification

Jurisdictions: Meets the requirements of Pennsylvania; Through interstate reciprocity agreements, you can convert your Pennsylvania Instructional I teaching certificate to an analogous teaching certificate in another state. Reciprocity is not automatic. Contact your specific state's Department of Education to determine what criteria will be required to complete the transfer.

Master of Science and Certificate Program in Low Vision Rehabilitation

Employment: Certification by the Academy for Certification of Vision Rehabilitation and Education Professionals

Jurisdictions: Meets the national standard

Program: Master of Science in Occupational Therapy

Employment: Occupational Therapist

Jurisdictions: Meets the requirements of all 50 States

Program: Master of Science in Speech-Language Pathology

Employment: Speech-Language Pathologist

Jurisdictions: Meets the requirements of all 50 States

Students are eligible to apply for their Certificate of Clinical Competence after completion of a 9 month supervised fellowship. Students are eligible to obtain certification as an Educational Specialist – School Speech and Language Pathologist PK-12.

Program: Master of Science in Orthotics and Prosthetics

Employment: Prosthetist/Orthotist

Licensure: Must pursue national level certification and obtain a state licensure in order to practice. Not all states require a licensure, while some have certification requirements.
